APA REFERENCE STYLE: Chapters in Edited Books

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.

Bing: Apa Citation Chapter In Edited

For chapters of edited books, put each author's last name, then a comma, then the first initial of the first name, then any additional initials. A period should follow each initial. Separate the last author from the second-to-last author with a comma and ampersand (&). Separate any additional authors by commas.

Article or Chapter in an Edited Book - APA Format ...

If there are different authors for each chapter, you need to reference EACH chapter you use. If you use multiple chapters

from a book with different authors for each chapter, you still need to reference EACH chapter you use. (This is because you need to acknowledge who wrote the work you are using, not the person who edited/compiled the book).

The information required when citing a single chapter from an edited volume is as follows: Author Name, Initial(s). (Year). Title of chapter. In Editor Name (Ed.), Title of book (page numbers). Publisher. For instance, this would look something like the following: Author, A. (2007). My essay.

To create a reference for a chapter in an edited book, follow the example for a chapter in an edited book without a DOI. At the end of the reference, after the publisher, add the DOI using the current DOI URL format. The current standard for the DOI begins with "https://doi.org/". Do not add a period after the DOI. To cite a chapter in a book in a reference entry in APA style 6th edition include the following elements: Author(s) of the chapter: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to seven authors with the last name preceded by an ampersand (&). For eight or more authors include the first six names followed by an ellipsis (...) and add the last author's name.

An edited book is where each chapter is by different author (s), and an editor (s) pulls them together and perhaps writes an introduction. You must cite/reference the individual chapter you used, rather than the book as a whole (it is possible you would cite and reference a number of chapters separately that are from the same edited book).

The structure is as follows: Last name of the chapter author, initial(s). (Year). Chapter title. In editor initial(s), surname (Ed.). Title (ed., pp.chapter page range). Retrieved from URL

Editor (Eds.), Title of the book (pp. xxx-xxx). Location: Publisher. Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (year). Title of the chapter or entry.
