The journey across England to Frongoch was tedious but enjoyable for most of the men especially when they reached the countryside of Wales, from which similarities to Ireland were drawn.

Frongoch had originally been used as a prisoner-of-war camp for German soldiers during the First World War, and it was here that 1,800 Irishmen were lodged in the aftermath of the Easter Rising.
