Applying developmentally appropriate practice. The overall goal for using Developmentally Appropriate Practice (DAP) is to support excellence in early childhood education through decision-making based on knowledge about individual children and child development principles combined with knowledge of effective early learning practices. To effectively apply developmentally appropriate practices in teaching and make decisions about children's learning and development, a practitioner should:

### Developmentally Appropriate Practices for Young Children ...

These three considerations make up the core of developmentally appropriate practice. The first core consideration is knowing about child development and learning. Child development follows general, sequential and predictable patterns. These patterns are interrelated across developmental domains, including physical, social, emotional and cognitive.

First, knowing what is expected at each stage of a young child's development is important, and informs decisions about best practices. 1. Another key factor is knowing what is appropriate for each individual child. Watching children in play activity can give important insights into their progress and abilities.

### **Guide To Developmentally Related Activities**

"Developmentally appropriate" describes an approach to teaching that respects both the age and the individual needs of

each child. The idea is that the program should fit the child; the child shouldn't have to fit the program! Preschool teachers look at the "whole child," including intellectual, social, emotional, physical, and creative growth.

### **Developmentally Appropriate Practices for Elementary ...**

1 Reading. Daily reading is the single most effective strategy for teaching preschoolers to read and encouraging a lifelong love of reading, according to the book "Early Literacy in Preschool and Kindergarten." Spend time reading to your child every day, and encourage her to pick books she likes.
