A private equity fund is also a managed investment fund that pools money, but they normally invest in private, non-publicly traded companies and businesses.

Private equity funds are mostly structured as closed-end investment vehicles. Private is started as a limited partnership by a fund manager or general partner. The fund manager sets forth the rules and regulations governing the fund. General Partner contributes around 1% to 3% of the total fund investment size.

fund. Unlike mutual funds or hedge funds, however, private equity firms often focus on long-term investment opportunities in assets that take time to sell with an investment time horizon typically of 10 or more years.
